2. Review each scholarship to which you are applying.
Make sure that you meet all criteria. **Scholarship requirement criteria and eligibility can be found online at sussex.edu/scholarships.**
3. Check off each scholarship you are applying for on page 3.
4. Submit an essay using the following questions as a guide:
Why do you feel you are deserving of this scholarship?
Why is a college education important to you?
What are your future college and/or career plans?
(We suggest that your submission be between 100 and 250 words total)
 - Please note some scholarships may require an additional essay. Please check the individual scholarship criteria.
 - Please be sure to address any specific requirements for each of the scholarships you are applying for in your essay questions and in any additional essays you submit.

Examples:

- a) Do you need to be 23 years of age or older?
- b) Are you active in campus activities?
- c) Are you a member of the Psychology Club?
- d) Are you related to a firefighter or police officer?
- e) What specific challenges or accomplishments have you met or attained?

The essay and any additional essays are important components of your application.
(Note: If you have applied for a scholarship in a previous semester, you must submit new material) Content, grammar and spelling are all important components of your application.

5. In order to apply for a scholarship – ALL APPLICANTS (except international students) are REQUIRED to file a FAFSA/Free Application for Federal Student Aid – Go to www.fafsa.gov to apply.
6. Provide **ONLY ONE** letter of recommendation in support of your candidacy unless otherwise noted under Special Criteria. Most students select a faculty member. Your letter of recommendation must be current and dated no earlier than the beginning of the Fall 2016 semester.
7. **Return your completed application (including the signed release form) to the Counseling and Advising Center, Room B-206, by the deadline, Tuesday, October 18, 2016 at 5:00 pm.**

- Scholarship funds will be applied to the student's account following the start of the Spring of 2017 semester. Funds are awarded to students who qualified based on the specified criteria of the scholarship. If the student fails to meet the specified criteria necessary to receive the scholarship or if the student's circumstances change, the Foundation reserves the right to rescind the scholarship offer and withdraw the award.

Please Note: The Scholarship will be awarded as follows One (1) check in the amount of \$750 to be issued at the time of the award, the second check in the amount of \$750 will be issued in within 12 months of the award only after the student's grades and proof of enrollment in the next semester are forward to the name and address listed above. Both checks are issued directly to SCCC in your name.

In the event the student does not supply the required documentation to receive the balance of the scholarship, then, after a period of 12 months from the date the scholarship was awarded, the balance of said scholarship will revert back to the scholarship fund.

The student must maintain a grade average of 3.0 to receive the second \$750 check.
An official transcript from the college to show proof of enrollment and grade point average is necessary before the second check of \$750 will be awarded.
