Tuesday, January 9

- Evening departure from Newark and overnight flight to Dublin

Wednesday, January 10

- Morning arrival Dublin airport.
- Meet and greet by Select study guide at the airport and private escorted motor coach transfer to Central Dublin. This will also include a 2 hour panoramic orientation of the city. Photo stops are included along the way.
- Afternoon check in to the hotel. Your guide will ensure students are settled into their rooms and comfortable with their surroundings.
- Validate Dublin bus pass providing free travel on the city's buses throughout your stay
- Overnight Dublin

Thursday, January 11

- Morning visit to Leinster House home of the Irish Parliament
- Afternoon guided tour of the Criminal Justice highlights of the city including Mountjoy Prison with its unique history of criminal justice Ireland, Old Dublin, Debtors Prison, Green Street Court House, Kings Inn and the Four Courts.
- Overnight Dublin

Friday, January 12

- Morning visit to a low security prison or juvenile detention center in Dublin. If this visit proves not possible it may be substituted with a visit to Kilmainham Gaol Museum.
- Afternoon visit to the Dublin Criminal Courts of Justice

- Morning guided introduction to Dublin including a visit to Trinity College and the Book of Kells. We also visit the National Museum of Ireland.
