



## Explanation of Fees

**General Fee Covers:** Supports SCCC's academic programs, library services, facilities, matters pertaining to student welfare, campus life and the collegiate environment.

**Student Services Fee:** Supports SGA, which supports clubs, organizations and committees chartered through the SGA. Any activities that are sponsored by the SGA are available to all students.

**Technology Fee:** Covers all technology that the college offers to the students including technology, wireless connections, library and more.

**Application Fee:** Covers the processing of the application and for the maintenance of a permanent record, along with your ID# associated with your account.

**Course Materials Fee:** Covers some of the cost of materials provided to students during the semester. Any copies that the instructors must make for classroom use, tests and or exams.

**Administrative Withdrawal Fee:** Charged per course that a student is registered for but does not attend. Non-attendance is provided by the instructor.

**Graduation Fee:** Covers the paperwork involved in preparing for your graduation from SCCC. This includes preparation for the program, the ceremony and the diploma.

**Lab Fees:** Charged to the student in conjunction with courses listed in the course descriptions for use of any materials for labs, i.e.: computer, science, technology.

**Late Payment Fee:** Student does not pay in full or have your financial aid in place on time, or have not started and kept up with an 'official' payment plan.

**Online Course Fee:** Covers the extra time that the instructor must take to work with online students along with the technology that goes with it.

**Returned Check Fee:** A check being returned to the college for insufficient funds.

**Transcript Fee** (first one is free): Covers the paperwork and the cost of sending the transcript.
