## 1 | Apply for Admission

## 2 | File for Financial Aid (Recommended)

Apply for financial aid at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). SCCC's School Code is **025688**. Once you complete your FAFSA and register for classes, contact the Financial Aid Office to determine the status of your aid, **973.300.2225**.



## 3 | Take the Placement Test (If needed)
