

<u>Accuplacer Placement Testing for PreCalculus and Calculus</u>

Placement testing is required for entrance into MATH110, MATH112, and MATH113. Students are required to take the Accuplacer Next-Generation Advanced Algebra and Functions test, formerly known as the CLM test. Accuplacer Placement Testing will be "In-Person" at the SCCC Testing Center (Room B317) and remotely with Proctortrack, if necessary.

You will need your SCCC Student ID# and a **valid** Photo ID (Driver's License or SCCC ID). Calculators and cell phones are **NOT** permitted during testing.

"In-Person" testing is preferred, but if you need to test remotely with Proctortrack, contact the Testing Center at 973-300-2155 or 973-300-2242 or email kcarr@sussex.edu or sunverzagt@sussex.edu for further instructions.

What Is The Cost?

Taking the Placement Test "In-Person" at SCCC is free for the initial test. There is a **\$10.00 re-test fee**. Only one re-test is allowed. Re-test forms are available at the Testing Center and payment can be made at the Bursar's office.

PLEASE NOTE: There is a \$32.00 student fee to test remotely with Proctortrack.

PREREQUISITES:

The prerequisite for MATH110 (PreCalculus I) and MATH112 (PreCalculus II) is a grade of C or better in MATH040 (Intermediate Algebra) or an appropriate score on the Accuplacer Next-Generation Advanced Algebra and Functions test (CLM). The prerequisite for MATH113 (Calculus I) is a grade of C or better in MATH110 (PreCalculus I) and MATH112 (PreCalculus II) or an appropriate score on the Accuplacer Next-Generation Advanced Algebra and Functions test (CLM).
