SOAR LEADER POSITION DESCRIPTION

SIX POSITIONS ARE AVAILABLE

Each year, a team of outstanding students will be selected to help guide incoming students as they transition from high school to Sussex County Community College. These students, known as SOAR Leaders, serve as resources for new students and their family members by:

- informing students and families about College life
- assisting new students in the process of building their first semester's schedule
- helping new students connect with faculty, staff and their peers.

SOAR leaders play a critical role in new students' academic, personal, and cultural integration at the College. The College administration and faculty recognize the important role SOAR leaders play, and consider these students as some of our campuses' top student leaders.

SOAR LEADERS RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING BENEFITS

- **A stipend equal to tuition for one 3 credit class**
- Personal and professional relationships with faculty, staff, and students
- Opportunity to develop highly-demanded communication, problem-solving and leadership skills

SOAR LEADER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Facilitate discussion with groups of incoming students
- Explain academic opportunities and procedures
- Model appropriate behavior and skills for successful SCCC student
- Acquaint new students with campus services and building locations

- Assist new students in the use of online tools such as **My Sussex Portal** etc.

QUALIFICATIONS - ALL APPLICANTS MUST:

- Exemplify attributes of being adaptable, approachable, dedicated, responsible, and supportive
- Exhibit a commitment to the College, new student and family programs, and the SOAR program
- Exhibit strong interpersonal and group communication skills
- Exhibit strong problem-solving and critical thinking skills
- Exhibit leadership potential and take the initiative
- Possess integrity and high ethical standards with a positive attitude

REQUIREMENTS - ALL APPLICANTS MUST:

1. Possess and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
2. Be registered to attend Sussex in Fall 2019
 - Participating in **10** SOAR Sessions from the end of April through early August.
3. Equal to approximately 30–40 hours
 - If unable to attend assigned SOAR Session, you must find suitable coverage within the SOAR Leadership Team.
4. Provide 2 Letters of Recommendation
5. Assist in the outreach to potential SOAR attendees
6. Attend the Leadership and Training sessions
 - Training sessions to be held in early April - dates TBD - approximately 3 to 4 hours. Most likely training dates will be on Fridays

SOAR DATES AND TIMES

- SOAR leader retreat and training activities – A maximum of three, 2-hr. Training sessions Fridays in early April.
- Each SOAR Session will last approximately 3-4 hours. You must be available for a light set up one hour before the Session begins.
