You may appeal for a reinstatement of financial aid eligibility by completing this form and submitting the items listed below. The circumstances under which a student would be permitted to submit an appeal are: death of a relative, injury or illness of the student or other special circumstances which you must document. Appeals must be submitted in writing to the Financial Aid Office two weeks prior to the start of the semester for which you are requesting reinstatement of aid. Appeals will not be reviewed without documentation.
